

**MONROE TOWNSHIP  
ORDINANCE NO. 2011-1**

An ordinance of the Township of Monroe rescinding Township Ordinance No. 2006-3, which provided for the establishment of the office of Township Manager.

WHEREAS, On December 19, 2006, Monroe Township enacted Township Ordinance No. 2006-3 which Ordinance established the office of Township Manger and included terms of appointment, term vacancy and removal as well as provisions regarding qualifications, compensation powers and duties.


WHEREAS, the Monroe Township Supervisors, at their organizational meeting of the Board of Supervisors on January 3, 2011 discussed the position and made the decision to eliminate the position of Township Manager and passed a motion that Ordinance 2006-3 be repealed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, as follows:


1. That Township Ordinance No. 2006-3 is hereby repealed.
2. That all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

DULY ENACTED AND ORDAINED this 25 day of January 2011, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Monroe, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, in lawful sessions duly assembled, after a public hearing following a minimum of seven (7) days notice and after proper notice of its intent to adopt this ordinance.


