

Ordinance #. 1

Approving and Adopting an Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of Hummels wharf Municipal Authority to Incease The Term of Its Existence, and Approving Sewer and water Projects of Said Authority.

The Board of Supervisors of The Township of Monroe, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, Hereby Ordains as follows:

Section 1

The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of Hummels wharf Municipal Authority, to be set forth in Articles of Amendment to be filed with the Secretary of The Commonwealth is hereby approved and adopted:

A new and final paragraph shall be added to said Articles of Incorporation reading "The term of existence of the Authority shall be increased to extend for fifty (50) years from the date of the approval of these Articles of Amendment by the Secretary of the Commonwealth"

Section 2

The plans of William E. Sees, Jr., Consultant Engineer for a Sanitary Sewerage System and Sewerage Treatment Plant to be constructed by said Authority at Hummels wharf are hereby approved in form submitted to this Board, and said Authority ~~is~~ requested to proceed with the financing and construction thereof.

Section 3

The plans of William E. Sees, Jr., Consulting Engineer for a water supply and water distribution system to be constructed by said Authority at Hummel's wharf are hereby approved in the form submitted to this Board, and said Authority is requested to proceed with the financing and construction thereof.

Section 4

Said plans of William E. Sees, Jr., are on file with Mrs. Dorothy M. Maylor, Sec. Hummel's wharf Municipal Authority, Hummel's wharf, Pennsylvania where they may be examined by interested persons.
