

ORDINANCE / - 1987

AN ORDINANCE OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SETTING COMPENSATION OF SUPERVISORS ELECTED AFTER OCTOBER 31, 1987.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 68 of 1985 setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class; and

WHEREAS, said act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of up to 4,999 shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars annually, and

WHEREAS, the population of Monroe Township is less than 5000; and

WHEREAS, the general Assembly by said Act 68 authorizes the boards of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the act, and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township to set compensation for supervisors on a monthly basis and within the limitations of Act 68.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1. Each Supervisor of Monroe Township elected or appointed to office on or after October 31, 1987, shall receive compensation for attending duly advertised general or special public meetings of the board of supervisors at the rate of One Hundred Twenty-Five

(\$125.00) Dollars per month, regardless of the number of meetings attended.

2. No supervisor shall receive annual compensation under this Ordinance in excess of the annual statutory limit set by the General Assembly in Act 68 for supervisors of townships within the appropriate populaton category.

3. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly installments.

4. This Ordinance shall be effective January 11, 1987.
