

ORDINANCE NO. 007-5

AN ORDINANCE OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING MONROE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 24 WHICH CREATES THE MONROE TOWNSHIP RECREATION BOARD AND AUTHORIZES THE MAINTENANCE, OPERATION AND SUPERVISION OF PUBLIC PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS AND FACILITIES BY CHANGING THE COMPOSITION OF THE MONROE TOWNSHIP RECREATION BOARD TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT THAT CERTAIN BOARD MEMBERS BE MEMBERS OF THE SCHOOL BOARD.

WHEREAS, Monroe Township Ordinance No. 24 creating the Monroe Township Recreation Board to maintain, operate, and supervise the public parks, the playfields, and all outdoor and indoor recreation areas and facilities under control by the Township of Monroe was adopted the 7th day of January, 1970; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the foregoing Ordinance requires the Board to be composed of Seven (7) persons, "two (2) of whom shall be members or appointees of the school board;" and

WHEREAS, recreation enabling legislation required two (2) members of the Recreation Board to be members or appointees of the school board only when the township has, in fact, a school board; and

WHEREAS, the Monroe Township Supervisors recognize that Monroe Township does not, in fact, have an independent school board and as such, there is no requirement that two (2) of the members of the Monroe Township Recreation Board also be members of the School Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1: That Section 2 of Monroe Township Ordinance No. 24 be amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the Board shall be composed of seven (7)

persons appointed by the supervisors and shall serve for terms of five (5) years or until their successors are appointed. Members of the Recreation Board shall serve without pay. All persons appointed shall serve their full terms unless voluntarily resigned or removed by the Board of Supervisors for dereliction or neglect of duty. Vacancies in such Board occurring otherwise than by expiration of term shall be for the unexpired term, and shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments.

Section 3: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 24 as adopted January 7, 1970, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption.
