A Resolution of the Township/Borough of Monroe concurring in the Resolution of the Commissioners of the County of Snyder which designated the Union County Tourist Promotion Agency to represent Snyder County for the purposes of the Tourist Promotion Law.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted the Tourist Promotion Law (Act of April 28, 1961, being Act 50 of the 1961 Regular Session) for the purpose of promoting the welfare of the people of the Commonwealth by the rendering of financial assistance to Tourist Promotion agencies engaged in promoting the development and expansion of business, industry and commerce in the respective counties of the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Tourist Promotion Law only one such Tourist Promotion agency shall be designated and qualified in each county to receive such financial assistance in accordance with the provisions of said law; and

WHEREAS, to so qualify for such financial assistance a Tourist Promotion agency must be designated for that purpose by the Board of County Commissioners of the county which such Tourist Promotion agency is to represent and such designation must be concurred in by resolutions of the governing bodies of such cities, boroughs or townships within the respective county having in the aggregate over 50 per centum of the population of said county; and

WHEREAS, the Union County Tourist Promotion Agency with its principal office at 418 Market Street, Lewisburg, Union County Pennsylvania, has requested that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Snyder, Pennsylvania, designate it as the Tourist Promotion Agency to represent Snyder County for the purposes of the Tourist Promotion Law; and

WHEREAS, the Union County Tourist Promotion Agency is agreeable at a future date to expand its name to reflect its representation of the tourist promotion interests of both Snyder and Union County; and

WHEREAS, it having been found that the Union County Tourist Promotion Agency is a duly constituted Tourist Promotion Agency as that term is defined in the Tourist Promotion Law; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Snyder County by Resolution 79-7, passed June 5, 1979, designated the Union County Tourist Promotion Agency to represent Snyder County for the purposes of the Tourist Promotion Law, subject to concurrence of the requisite number of townships and boroughs of the county.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the governing body of Monroe Township concur in the action of the Snyder County Commissioners designating the Union County Tourist Promotion Agency to represent the interests of Snyder County in regard to the Tourist Promotion Law of Pennsylvania.

RESOLUTION

A Resolution of the Board of Supervisors/~~Borough Council~~ of Monroe Township/~~Borough~~ authorizing the Snyder County Commissioners to coordinate and administer the Local Bridge Inventory and Inspection Program in Monroe Township/~~Borough~~.

WHEREAS, a systematic bridge inspection program will be of value in maintaining a quality highway system in Monroe Township/~~Borough~~; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation has made funds available from the Federal allocation to finance 80 percent of such a program; and

WHEREAS, the Snyder County Commissioners have agreed to coordinate such a program through the calendar year 1980, and to provide the 20 percent local funding; and

WHEREAS, the Snyder County Commissioners will coordinate the bridge inspection program in consultation with local authorities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Snyder County Commissioners are hereby authorized to act on behalf of Monroe Township/~~Borough~~ in the coordination and administration of the Local Bridge Inventory and Inspection Program through December 31, 1980.
