

A Resolution of the Township/Borough of MONROE TOWNSHIP concurring in Snyder County Resolution No. 1984-5 designating the Snyder County Travel Promotion Agency to represent Snyder County for the purposes of the promotion of tourism.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted the Tourist Promotion Law (Act of April 28, 1961, being Act 50 of the 1961 Regular Session) for the purpose of promoting the welfare of the people of the Commonwealth by the rendering of financial assistance to tourist promotion agencies engaged in promoting the development and expansion of business, industry, and commerce in the respective counties of the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Tourist Promotion Law only one such Tourist Promotion Agency shall be designated and qualified in each county to receive such financial assistance in accordance with the provisions of said law; and

WHEREAS, to so qualify for such financial assistance a Tourist Promotion Agency must be designated for that purpose by the Board of County Commissioners of the county which such Tourist Promotion Agency is to represent and such designation must be concurred in by resolutions of the governing bodies of such cities, boroughs, or townships within the respective county having over 50 percentum of the population of said county; and

WHEREAS, the Snyder County Travel Promotion Agency with its principal office located in the Snyder County Court House, Middleburg, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, has requested that the Board of Commissioners of Snyder County, Pennsylvania, designate it as the Tourist Promotion Agency to represent Snyder County for the purposes of the Tourist Promotion Law; and

WHEREAS, it having been found that the Snyder County Travel Promotion Agency is a duly constituted Tourist Promotion Agency as that term is defined in the Tourist Promotion Law; and

WHEREAS, the Snyder County Board of Commissioners by Snyder County Resolution No. 1984-5, adopted June 26, 1984, designated the Snyder County Travel Promotion Agency to represent Snyder County for the purposes of the Tourist Promotion Law, subject to the concurrence of the requisite number of townships and boroughs of Snyder County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the governing body of MONROE TOWNSHIP concur in the action of the Snyder County Board of Commissioners designating the Snyder County Travel Promotion Agency to represent the interests of Snyder County with regard to the Tourist Promotion Law of Pennsylvania.
