RESOLUTION OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY
PENNSYLVANIA, EXPRESSING THE CONSENT OF THE AUTHORITY TO THE
JOINDER OF UNION COUNTY AS A MEMBER MUNICIPALITY

WHEREAS, on the 10th day of December, 1984, the Board of Commissioners of Union County, Pennsylvania, adopted a Resolution indicating its desire to become a member of the Penn Valley Airport Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Penn Valley Airport Authority believes it to be in the best interest of the Authority to consent to the joinder of Union County; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945 requires that the governing bodies of each of the member municipalities join in the filing of the Application or joinder which Application is filed by the Authority with the Secretary of the Commonwealth:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania does hereby express its consent to the joinder of Union County as a member municipality pursuant to the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945; and

THAT the officers of the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, are hereby authorized and directed to sign any and all documents as may be necessary to effectuate the joining of said county to the Penn Valley Airport Authority.
