

RESOLUTION 1991-3

At a regular meeting of the Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, held in the Township Building, Hummels Wharf, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, on February 12, 1991, there were present:

The Chairman, Lee A. Shaffer, offered the following Resolution and moved it's adoption.

WHEREAS, the Snyder County Solid Waste Authority has proposed a "Snyder County Municipal Waster Management Plan" for all of Snyder County; and

WHEREAS, unless the individual Township affirmatively rejects the Snyder County Municipal Waster Management Plan, the Plan will automatically go into effect; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Monroe Township have voted to reject the Snyder County Municipal Waste Management Plan for the following specific reasons:

- A. Monroe Township has in effect at the present time an adequate recycling plan.
- B. The Township has just entered into a ten (10) year contract with the Lycoming County Landfill Authority for disposal of municipal waste of Monroe Township.
- C. The Snyder County Municipal Waste Management Plan contains no specifics regarding direction and implementation of same.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, for the foregoing reasons, rejects participation in the Snyder County

Municipal Waste Management Plan proposed by the Snyder County Solid Waste Authority.

And finally, the Township is directed to file a copy of this Resolution with Snyder County Waste Authority at it's office in the Snyder County Courthouse, Middleburg, Snyder County, Pennsylvania.
