RESOLUTION 2003-4

Whereas, the traffic congestion on Routes 11 & 15 between Selinsgrove and Shamokin Dam Borough has, for years, been acknowledged as a serious problem, and

Whereas, continued traffic growth on this vital stretch of roadway remains an impediment to the full economic development and vitality of the Central Susquehanna Valley and a detriment to the quality of life of its residents, and

Whereas, since 1972 the need for an extension of the Routes 11 & 15 By-pass of Selinsgrove to resolve this problem has been acknowledged and

Whereas, Penn DOT currently has a viable plan for this by-pass and related traffic projects know as the "Susquehanna Valley Transportation Project," and

Whereas, the construction of the proposed "By-pass and the related Route 61 Connector," which are parts of the "Susquehanna Valley Transportation Project" will have an impact upon Monroe Township area, and

Whereas, the community may generally accept and support these plans and believe they may resolve this serious problem and may help to increase the safety of our valley residents, the traveling public and commercial interests that depend upon Routes 11 & 15

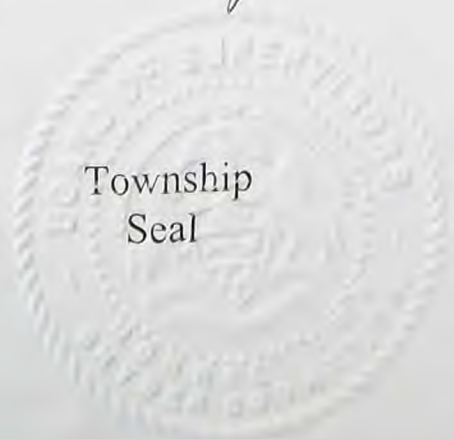
Whereas, the Monroe Township Board of Supervisors would like action to be taken by Penn DOT in regards to the acquisition of right of ways and easements throughout Monroe Township.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania do hereby join with the Greater Susquehanna Valley Chamber of Commerce in calling on Senator Rick Santorum (Senator Arlen Specter) (Congressman Don Sherwood) to work for the insertion of \$170,000,000, adjusted for inflation, into the Transportation Authorization Bill currently being planned and that this money be earmarked specifically for the parts of the Susquehanna Valley Transportation Project know as the "By-pass and Route 61 Connector."

Resolution 2003-4 was duly enacted on April 29, 2003 at the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania.




