At a meeting of the Supervisors of the Township of Monroe, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, held at the Monroe Township Municipal Building, Hummels Wharf, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, on April 29, 2003, there were present the following Supervisors:

Supervisor Dean Davis offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Monroe Township, on March 25, 2003 adopted Ordinance 2003-2 which ordinance provides, inter alia, for private street signs; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance requires that signs identifying private roads be a brown background with white lettering; and

WHEREAS, Monroe Township public roads are marked with signs containing a green background with white lettering.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, hereby resolves that the signs identifying private roads shall be **white background with green lettering** rather than brown with white lettering as provided in Monroe Township Ordinance 2003-2.

AND FINALLY, the Township Secretary is directed to file a copy of this Resolution with the District Engineer of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in Montoursville, Pennsylvania, and in the Office of the Prothonotary, Snyder County Courthouse, Middleburg, Snyder County, Pennsylvania.


