

ORDINANCE NO. 92 - 7

An Ordinance of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, amending Ordinance 75 - 3 requiring all persons, partnerships, business and corporations to obtain a building permit for reconstruction, enlargement, alteration or relocation of any building or structure; providing for the issuance of such building permits; and providing for penalties for any persons who fail or refuse to comply with the requirements or provisions of the Ordinance.

Section 1: - Purposes: This Ordinance is adopted for the purpose of amending Ordinance 75-3 to increase building permit fees of those persons, partnerships, businesses and corporations who start construction prior to the issuance of a building permit.

Section 2: Section 8 of the Ordinance is restated and amended as follows:

Section 8 - Fees

Application for a building permit shall be accompanied by a fee, payable to Monroe Township based upon the estimated cost of the proposed construction as determined by the Building Permit Officer at the following rates:

Estimated Cost	Fee
\$0.00 to \$1,000.00	
Each additional \$1,000.00 or part thereof beyond the first \$1,000.00	\$5.00

In addition to the foregoing fee, if construction has been started prior to the issuance of a building permit by the Monroe Township Building Permit Officer an additional Ten (\$10.00) Dollars shall be paid to Monroe Township at the time the building permit is issued.



Section 3 - Severability: If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township, that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such constitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.

Section 4 - Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.
