

**MONROE TOWNSHIP  
ORDINANCE NO. 2011-3**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE RESCINDING TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 1987-3 WHICH REGULATED THE HEIGHT OF GRASS, WEEDS, AND OTHER VEGETATION IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS.

WHEREAS, on January 5, 1987, Monroe Township enacted Township Ordinance No. 1987-3, which Ordinance regulated the height of grass, weeds and other vegetation in residential areas and provided for penalties for violation.

WHEREAS, Township Ordinance No. 1987-3 has been rendered unnecessary by adoption of Monroe Township Ordinance No. 2010-3 which created the Monroe Township Property Maintenance Code.


WHEREAS, the Monroe Township Supervisors, at their meeting of the Board of Supervisors on February 22, 2011 discussed Township Ordinance No. 1987-3 and made the decision to rescind said Ordinance and passed a motion that Township Ordinance No. 1987-3 be repealed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, as follows:


1. That Township Ordinance No. 1987-3 is hereby repealed.
2. That all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.




