

ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PEACE, QUIET, AND GOOD ORDER OF THE INHABITANTS OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNEYSLVANIA

WHEREAS, the inhabitants of Monroe Township are entitled to peace and quiet and good order within the limits of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the maintenance of peaceable order is a function of township government,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordain as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful within the limits of the Township of Monroe for any person or persons to be at, or upon any house, building, ground, premises, street, land, alley, street corner, or in an intoxicated or drunken condition, or behaving in a rude or boisterous manner, or disturbing the peace in any way.

2. Violators of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, pay a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), together with costs for each violation thereof, as other fines and penalties by law are recoverable, to be paid into the township general fund and in default of payment thereof may be committed to jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.
