

RESOLUTION NO. 2000 – 3

At a meeting of the Supervisors of the Township of Monroe, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, held at the Monroe Township Municipal Building, Hummels Wharf, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, on August 29, 2000, there were present the following Supervisors:

1. Timothy L. Wolfe
2. Dean K. Davis
3. Steve E. Paige

Supervisor Dean K. Davis offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, properties along the Susquehanna River and its tributaries are subject to flooding;

WHEREAS, the Luzerne County Flood Protection Authority has authorized funding to support the preparation of a hazard mitigation plan for the Township of Monroe;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisors of Monroe Township that:

1. The Township of Monroe wants to develop a hazard mitigation plan for the affected area after a review of all hazard mitigation options based on the flood hazard, building conditions, the desires of the property owners, and available funding sources.
2. A Mitigation Planning Committee is hereby established. Its members shall be:
3. The Mitigation Planning Committee is charged with the following:
 - a. Collect data on the flood hazard, building conditions, the desires of the property owners, and funding sources for flooding protection activities;
 - b. Identify high hazard areas that could be designated as target areas appropriate for acquisition, clearance and conversion to open space;
 - c. Prepare a hazard mitigation plan for the Township of Monroe that recommends mitigation measures appropriate for the natural hazards facing the Township of Monroe;
 - d. Keep the public informed of its deliberations and recommendations; and
 - e. Work closely with and help the mitigation planning team provided by the Luzerne County Flood Protection Authority.


4. Owners of property in the affected area are encouraged to:
- a. Attend public meetings to review Monroe Township's mitigation planning activities and recommendations; and
 - b. Cooperate with the mitigation planners so they can collect accurate data on buildings and past hazards.




Upon roll-call vote the Resolution was unanimously adopted.


