

RESOLUTION NO. 2006 - 4

*A Resolution for Municipal Adoption of the  
Snyder County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan*

WHEREAS the Township of Monroe, Snyder County, is most vulnerable to natural hazards such as flooding, hurricanes/tropical storms, and severe winter weather, and also vulnerable to human-caused hazards that can result in loss of life, property loss, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS a Snyder County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Snyder County Board of Commissioners, the Snyder County Planning Department, Snyder County Emergency Management Agency, local elected officials, and the citizens of Snyder County, and

WHEREAS the Snyder County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-caused hazards that face the Township of Monroe, and

WHEREAS a series of public meetings were held to develop and review the plan, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Monroe acknowledges the requirement of Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and


WHEREAS, the Township of Monroe currently has an already adopted Hazards Mitigation Plan, and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Monroe desires to adopt the Snyder County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan as a multi-jurisdictional plan, as a supplement to the existing Hazards Mitigation Plan of the Township of Monroe.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Monroe that:

- The existing Hazard Mitigation Plan for the Township of Monroe is hereby retained as an official plan of the Township of Monroe; and
- The Snyder County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official plan of the Township of Monroe; and
- The respective Officials and Agencies identified in the strategy of the Snyder County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.
