

ORDINANCE NO. 1985-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING OF VEHICLES OF ALL TYPES ON THE PAVED PORTION (INCLUDING SHOULDERS) OF LEGISLATIVE ROUTE 25, LEGISLATIVE ROUTE 24 AND LEGISLATIVE ROUTE 25 SPUR (AS THEY COMPRISE U. S. ROUTE 11 & 15 IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE) AT ANY LOCATION WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE, COUNTY OF SNYDER AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has approved a "No Parking" Zone along the paved portions of Legislative Route 25, Legislative Route 24 and Legislative Route 25 spur (as they comprise U. S. Route 11 & 15 in the Township of Monroe):

THEREFORE, be it Enacted and Ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Monroe, County of Snyder and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, at a duly constituted meeting and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by the authority of the same:

Section One: That the parking of vehicles of all types be and is hereby prohibited at all times on the paved portion (including paved shoulders) of Legislative Route 25, Legislative Route 24 and Legislative Route 25 spur (as they comprise U. S. Route 11 & 15 in the Township of Monroe) at any location within the Township of Monroe, County of Snyder and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; said roads are shown on the plan of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on file in the Monroe Township Building.

Section Two: The areas where parking is prohibited pursuant to Section One of this Ordinance are to be designated by

the erection of "No Parking" signs purchased and erected by Monroe Township.

Section Three: Any person violating Section One of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before a Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution.

Section Four: This Ordinance to become effective immediately upon the posting of the proper "No Parking" signs by the Township of Monroe, County of Snyder and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section Five: All Ordinances, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section Six: Should any Section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any parts thereof.
