

ORDINANCE NO. 1992-2

AN ORDINANCE OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS FOR MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that stop intersections be established in Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Monroe Township Supervisors that such stop intersections are appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained, by the Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1: The following intersections are established as stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the intersection of the through Street. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first named or stopped Street, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the intersecting or through Street until he/she has followed all applicable requirements of that Section of the Law.

Section 2: The Locations of the Stop signs are as set forth in the attached document designated the Monroe Township Stop Sign and Traffic Light Listing which is incorporated herein by reference.



Section 3: Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption.
