AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1992-2 AND ORDINANCE 2001-~~1~~<sup>1</sup> WHICH ESTABLISHED STOP INTERSECTIONS IN TOWNSHIP OF MONROE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Monroe Township Board of Supervisors that the within Amendment is appropriate due the addition of a three-way stop intersection at the intersection of Greenbrier Avenue and Lost Creek Drive

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**Section 1:** Section 2: Locations of Stop Signs The Locations of the Stop signs at the intersection of Greenbrier Avenue and Lost Creek Drive are as set forth in the attached document designated as T-444 Greenbrier Avenue & T-606 Lost Creek Drive Stop Sign Ord. is incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 2:** Provisions remaining in effect: All other provisions of Monroe Township Ordinances 1992-2 and 2001-~~1~~<sup>1</sup> shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3:** Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption.
