

ORDINANCE NO. 2007 - 1

AN ORDINANCE OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS FOR MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

WHEREAS, Monroe Township Supervisors, by Ordinance No. 1992 – 2, have adopted an Ordinance establishing stop intersections for Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania;

WHEREAS, Monroe Township Supervisors, by Ordinance Nos. 2001 – 1 and 2002 – 2, made changes to the original Ordinance No. 1992 -2;

WHEREAS, the majority of the roads in Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, have been renamed due to the emergency 911 mapping in Snyder County, Pennsylvania;

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that stop intersections be re-established in Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania due to the changes of road names;

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Monroe Township Supervisors that such stop intersections are appropriate and shall be re-established.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained, by the Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1: The following intersections are established as stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the intersection of the through Street. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first named or stopped Street,

in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the intersecting or through Street until he/she has followed all applicable requirements of that Section of the Law.

Section 2: The Locations of the Stop signs are as set forth in the attached document designated the Monroe Township Stop Sign Plan which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3: Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs.


Section 4: Ordinance Nos. 1992-2, 2001-1, and 2002-2 and any other Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption.






