

**ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 9**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING PARKING OF VEHICLES OF ALL TYPES ON CERTAIN ROADS OR PORTIONS THEREOF IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE, COUNTY OF SNYDER AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

**WHEREAS**, it is the opinion of the Monroe Township Board of Supervisors that the within Ordinance is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Monroe Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the parking of vehicles of all types be and is hereby prohibited at all times (except as otherwise noted) on certain roads or portions thereof in the Township of Monroe, County of Snyder and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows:

1. The entire length of Saw Mill Road from 7 AM until 4 PM
2. The entire length of Blue Hill Drive
3. The entire length of Monroe Street
4. Mill Road from Old Trail to the intersection of Fox Avenue with Mill Road
5. The entire length of River Road
6. In the turn around at the Intersection of Jefferson Avenue and South Old Trail
7. In the turn around located at the south end of South Old Trail
8. The entire length of Penns Drive

SECTION 2: The areas where parking is prohibited pursuant to Section 1 of this Ordinance are to be designated by the erection of "No Parking" signs purchased and erected by Monroe Township.



SECTION 3: Any person who shall violate the terms or conditions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for a term not to exceed 90 days, or both. Each day that a violation continues after notice of the violation has been served shall be deemed to be a separate offense.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the posting of the proper "No Parking" signs by the Township of Monroe, County of Snyder and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Should any Section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any parts thereof.


