

ORDINANCE NO. 2013 -

AN ORDINANCE OF MONROE TOWNSHIP ESTABLISHING A STOP INTERSECTION AT PICNIC LANE AND BOGAR DRIVE AND RE-ESTABLISHING ALL OTHER STOP INTERSECTIONS FOR MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

WHEREAS, Monroe Township Supervisors, by Ordinance No. 2007-1, have adopted an Ordinance establishing stop intersections for Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania;

WHEREAS, Monroe Township Supervisors, by Ordinance No. 2008-4, made changes to the original Ordinance No. 2007-1;

WHEREAS, a new stop intersection needs to be established at the intersection of Picnic Lane and Bogar Drive;

WHEREAS, Monroe Township Supervisors desire to re-establish all other stop intersections for the reason that a map is now used to designate stop intersections instead of a table outlining same; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Monroe Township Supervisors that such stop intersections are appropriate and shall be re-established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1: All intersections marked with a stop sign on the 3' x 3' Monroe Township Stop Sign Plan, prepared by Meck-Tech Incorporated, dated September 17, 2013 and bearing the project number of 0754.Mo01, are hereby declared to be stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected (or hereby confirmed if previously erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the intersection of the through Street. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection of the through street shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) and any other applicable Sections of the Vehicle Code, and shall not proceed into or across the intersecting or through Street until he/she has followed all applicable requirements of law. The Monroe Township Stop Sign Plan set forth above is kept in the Monroe Township Building and is incorporated herein

by reference.

Section 2: Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs.


Section 3: Ordinance Nos. 2007-1, 2008-4, and any other Ordinances inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.



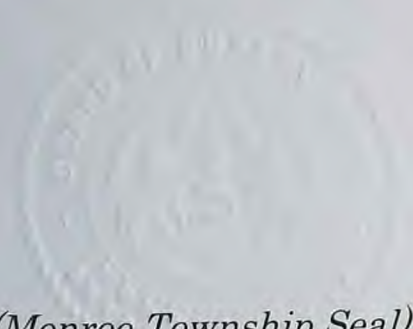


