

ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING OF VEHICLES OF ALL TYPES ON HIGHWAY LEGISLATIVE ROUTE 25 AT OR NEAR TWO BUSINESS PLACES ie. BONANZA STEAK HOUSE AND KINNEY SHOE STORE, WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE, COUNTY OF SNYDER AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has approved a "No Parking" Zone at the aforementioned location;

Be it Enacted and Ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Monroe, County of Snyder and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, at a duly constituted meeting and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by the authority of the same;

SECTION ONE: That the parking of vehicles of all types be and is hereby prohibited at all times on Highway Legislative Route 25 on the North side of said highway between station 653 plus 00 and station 656 plus 18 as shown on the plans of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on file in the Monroe Township Municipal Building, Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION TWO: The areas where parking is prohibited pursuant to Section One of this Ordinance are to be designated by the erection of "No Parking" signs purchased and erected by Monroe Township.

SECTION THREE: Penalty: Any person violating Section One of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before a Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof shall undergo imprisonment of not more than five (5) days.

SECTION FOUR: Effective Date: This Ordinance to become effective immediately upon the posting of the proper "No Parking" signs by the Township of Monroe, Snyder County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION FIVE: All Ordinances, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION SIX: Should any Section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision
