

ORDINANCE NO. 75-5

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM FOR MONROE TOWNSHIP AS REQUIRED BY ACT OF ASSEMBLY NO. 208, 1974 AMENDING THE PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACILITY ACT (ACT OF JANUARY 24, 1966) P. E. 1535 AS AMENDED (35 - P.S. 750.1 AT SEQ.

WHEREAS, the amendments to the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act set forth in Act 208-1974 specifically require each municipality to establish a program for insuring the proper disposal of sewage and proper compliance with the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township is obligated to comply with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act; and

WHEREAS, Snyder County Planning Commission has offered to assist all Snyder County Municipalities in complying with the new requirements of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved:

SECTION ONE: That the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township hereby designate to Snyder County Planning Commission to administer the provisions of Section 7 of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act for Monroe Township.

SECTION TWO: That the Snyder County Planning Commission shall be authorized on behalf of Monroe Township to promulgate procedures and regulations for the administration of Section 7 of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act and the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township hereby agree to comply with any regulations or procedures promulgated by the Snyder County Planning Commission.

SECTION THREE: That Monroe Township agrees to pay all costs incurred by the Snyder County Planning Commission in administering the Sewage Enforcement Program on a pro-rate share based on the number of units of worked for Monroe Township in relation to the total number of units of work performed for municipalities participating in the program.

SECTION FOUR: That the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township may, at any time, withdraw their designation of the Snyder County Planning Commission to administer the program.

SECTION FIVE: All Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION SIX: If any sentences, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason is found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect, or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, that this Ordinance would have been adopted at such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.

SECTION SEVEN: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.
