

ORDINANCE NO. 1994-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING MONROE TOWNSHIP TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGHES OF SELINGSGROVE AND SHAMOKIN DAM, TOWNSHIP OF PENN, HUMMELS WHARF MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY, PENN TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY, AND SELINGSGROVE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY, ALL OF SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO FORM AND FURNISH ASSETS TO A JOINT MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY TO BE KNOWN AS EASTERN SNYDER COUNTY REGIONAL AUTHORITY.

The Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

**SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR ORDINANCE.** This Ordinance is adopted with and pursuant to authority granted by Sections 65740 and 65741 of the Second Class Township Code [53 P.S. § 65740 & § 65741] as amended.

**SECTION 2. PURPOSE.** It is the desire of the Supervisors of Monroe Township to enter into an agreement with the Boroughs of Selingsgrove and Shamokin Dam, the Township of Penn, Hummels Wharf Municipal Authority, Penn Township Municipal Authority, and Selingsgrove Municipal Authority ("the Agreement") for the formation of a joint municipal authority under the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, Act No. 164, May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, as amended, for the purpose of such joint municipal authority acquiring, holding, constructing, improving, maintaining, operating, owning, and leasing, either in the capacity of lessor or lessee, the project consisting of sewers, sewer systems, parts of sewer systems, works for treating and disposing of sewage and industrial waste, and all related facilities necessary or desirable to accept, convey, treat, and dispose of sewage and industrial waste from the collection system of each and every one of the parties to the Agreement. A copy of the Agreement, marked Exhibit A, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

**SECTION 3. AGREEMENT.** The Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township authorizes Monroe Township to enter into the Agreement and directs the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and the Township Secretary to execute the Agreement and seal the same with the Township Seal.

**SECTION 4. CONDITION.** The authority granted under this Ordinance is conditioned upon each and every other party named in the Agreement entering into and executing the same within 60 days of the date hereof and in the event one or more of the named parties fails to enter the Agreement then this Ordinance shall be null and void and of no further effect.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall take effect 5 days after the date of its enactment.
