

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE IMPLEMENTING THE "PENNSYLVANIA SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT 537" REQUIRING PERMITS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE SYSTEMS, ESTABLISHING INSPECTION FEES AND PROVIDING REMEDIES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

1. No person shall install an individual or community sewage system, or construct any building in the Township of Monroe in which an individual or community sewage disposal system is to be installed without first obtaining a permit indicating that the site, plans and specifications of such system are in compliance with the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act 537" and the Rules and Regulations adopted pursuant to the act.

2. A fee in the sum of Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) shall be paid to the Township of Monroe at the time of making application for an individual or sewage disposal system.

3. Percolation tests and other inspections under this ordinance within the limits of the Township of Monroe shall be made ~~by~~ <sup>under the supervision</sup> of an individual qualified by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Health, to make such tests which individual shall be appointed by a Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the Township. The individual so appointed shall make report of said test to the township and to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Health.

4. In case any permit is denied or revoked, a hearing shall be held thereon before the governing body of this municipality within fifteen(15) days after request thereof is made by the applicant. Within 7 days following the date of such hearing the applicant shall be notified in writing of the determination of said hearing

5. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance or of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act which is incorporated herein by reference or the rules, regulations and standards promulgated thereunder or resist or interfere with any inspector or other officer, agent or employee of this municipality in the performance of his duties under this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding before any Justice of the Peace in Snyder County be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$100.00 and costs and of not more than \$300.00 and costs, or in default thereof shall be confined in the County jail for a period of not more than thirty (30) days.
